



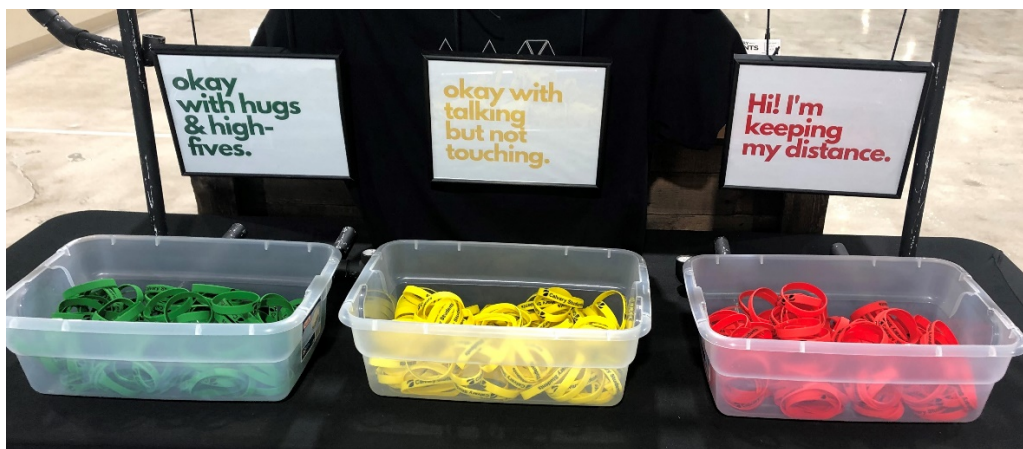
Student Ministry Gatherings COVID Protocols

Masks/Shields and Hand Sanitizer

- All Students/Leaders are required to wear a mask/shield while indoors and social distancing is not possible. While outside or when programming allows social distancing, masks/shields may be removed.
- No sharing or touching other individuals masks/shields.
- Hand Sanitizer stations are set up around our programming areas to provide access quickly and frequently.

Check-In

- Upon entering our Student Ministry Areas, Students must check in with our Calvary Students Team where we will have one team member mark off "role sheets" so we will know who is present with us. As a student/leader arrives, they simply tell us their grade and their name.
- Guests will need to have a "New Here" card filled out with their information. A leader will be assigned to fill out the card while asking the student/parent for the correct information.
- After you are successfully checked-in, students and leaders will select a colored wristband from the container that identifies their level of comfortability with distance and contact. All colors are 100% okay, they will just help us identify how to best engage students throughout the night in appropriate ways. This will be done in a way to where it will be a fun way to know how to "love our neighbors". At the end of the night, students/leaders will drop their wristband into a container by the exit that has a sanitizer solution in it. These bands will be thoroughly cleaned and then used the next week.
 - Green is that they are okay for a fist bump or pat on the shoulder.
 - Yellow is that they are okay with talking or sitting closely but no contact.
 - Red is that they are desiring to maintain social distancing completely.



Temperature Checks

- Before entering the building, we will be taking temperatures of each student/leader/parent to ensure that no one has a fever. If a temperature check reads 100.4 or higher, that individual will not be permitted to enter our facilities.

Bathrooms

- Bathrooms will have signage to allow a maximum of 3 people at one time. Designated leaders will refresh the bathrooms periodically to ensure a clean space.
- Water fountains will be closed due to it being a high contact area. Cups of water will be provided during the programming time for students to grab, drink, and throw away.

Dinner

- We will be providing dinner by boxing or wrapping up the prepared food so that students/leaders can simply grab and go. There will be no trading of food items with other students. You simply get what you are going to eat, eat it, and throw away the trash.

Dismissal/Pick-Up

- Our programming ends at 8:00, but if you are in need of getting your student earlier that will be done the same way. We would prefer for everyone to use the Text To Go to reduce the number of people in and out of the buildings; however, if your student doesn't have a phone, you will need to wear a mask/shield as you enter the buildings. Let us know your students name and grade, and we will make sure to get your student to you.
 - Text To Go: When you are ready for your student to come to the car, just send them a text that you are ready. They will confirm that with their leader or one of our Calvary Students Staff and then head to the car.
 - Grab and Go: If your student doesn't have a way for you to let them know you are outside, just walk in to our check in area and tell us your student's name and grade, and we will bring them to you. Please wear a mask/shield when you are entering our buildings.

Symptoms, Exposure, and Positive Test Protocol for Return to Ministry Events

Students/Leaders who have symptoms, have been exposed to COVID-19, or have tested positive for COVID-19 must follow the procedures outlined below.

Have Symptoms

- Anyone who is showing symptoms of COVID-19 or any sickness at all will be asked to not attend programming while sick or showing symptoms.
- We would encourage individuals to quarantine and contact his/her health provider to seek direction.

Exposed to Individual with Positive COVID-19

- If the exposure was not close/personal contact (just being with or in same environment with) along with no symptoms, there is no restriction or action that is needed.

- If the exposure is close/personal/physical contact (prolonged time, physical contact), then students/leaders will be asked to be absent from programming for 10 days before returning to programming.

Test Positive for COVID-19

Before you can return to the ministry programming, you must have a “negative test result” along with:

- Being fever free for 24 hours without fever reducing medications
- AND, symptoms have improved
- AND, seven days have passed since symptoms first appeared
- AND, a physician's written release

COVID-19 Symptoms

The following symptoms are currently listed by the CDC and other health organizations.

- Fever (100.4 and above)
- Chills
- Shortness of Breath
- Cough
- Loss of taste/smell
- Nasal Congestion/Runny Nose
- Diarrhea
- Fatigue
- Nausea/Vomiting
- Headache
- Muscle or body aches
